Kaltag AVEC Subdivision

The village of Kaltag is situated on a bluff overlooking the Yukon River in Alaska's Interior.

PDC surveyors were contracted by the Alaska Village Electrical Cooperative to subdivide a tract of Gana-A'Yoo Native Corporation-owned land to provide acreage for a fuel oil tank farm. The Kaltag fuel oil pipeline improvements will provide safe and efficient heating fuel access to the Jimmy Huntington School and surrounding residential area.

Lease lots were also created and monumented for the fuel oil pipeline and tank farm access road. The final subdivision plat was drafted according to the Department of Natural Resources Platting Authority for the Unorganized Borough.
